## **HPSS-S101 Description**

**S101 sections 03, 04, 13, 17, and 18 topic:**

### **Power and Ownership**

This course introduces students to critical reading, analysis and writing in the social sciences. You will develop these skills through the study of international politics. Substantively, we explore interests, interactions, and institutions of international and domestic political actors with regard to security and conflict, international political economy, and transnational politics. Student learning is grounded in international relations theories that include realism, liberalism, and constructivism.
